DUTIES OF THE PRESIDING JUDGE Submitted Cases (California Rule of Court 10.603(c)(3))

The Presiding Judge shall supervise and monitor the number of causes under submission before the judges of the court and ensure that no cause under submission remains undecided and pending for longer than 90 days. As an aid in accomplishing this goal:

- 1. Each judicial officer and subordinate judicial officer shall report on all causes under submission for 31 days or more, and designate the time period in which it has remained under submission; and
- 2. The court supervisor shall prepare and circulate monthly a calendar of all submitted causes to each judicial officer and subordinate judicial officer.
