GENERAL ORDER 2023-01

PILOT PROJECT - LIMITED eDELIVERY FILINGS - DCSS

To enable the Court to evaluate the feasibility and effectiveness of instituting direct electronic filing of court documents, a pilot project permitting the limited filing of documents under certain conditions will be allowed. Any electronic filing other than that as authorized by this order or by other rule of court will be rejected and will not be accepted by the Clerk.

- (a) In the initial phase of this pilot project, filings will be accepted from the Lassen County Department of Child Support Services.
- (b) The court will make available to pilot project participants a procedure and/or application/interface for electronically delivering (eDelivering) filings to the court.
- (c) Upon receipt of an eDelivered document, the court will promptly send a confirmation of receipt of the document indicating the date and time of receipt to the party or person who submitted the document.
- (d) If the document received complies with filing requirements and all required filing fees, if applicable, have been paid, the court will send confirmation that the document has been filed to the party or person who submitted the document.
- (e) If the clerk of the court does not file a document received by the court because the document does not comply with applicable filing requirements or the required filing fee has not been paid, the court will send notice of rejection of the document for filing to the party o person who submitted the document. The notice of rejection will state the reasons that the document was rejected for filing and include the date the clerk of the court sent the notice.
