I understand that if I am convicted of a violation of section 14601.2, or if the original charge was for a violation of that section but I am pleading to section 14601, 14601.1 or 14601.5, the Court will require me to install an ignition interlock device (IID) on any vehicle that I own or operate for a period of up to three years. Installation of this device, which prevents the vehicle from starting if I have alcohol in my body, does not authorize me to drive without a valid driver's license. Failure to install the IID shall result in the suspension of my driver's license by the DMV.

## CONSEQUENCES OF PLEA OF GUILTY OR NO CONTEST

- **20.** I have read and understood the penalty charts which list the minimum and maximum penalties for the offense(s) I am charged with. (See item No. 27 for the offenses not listed in the charts.)
